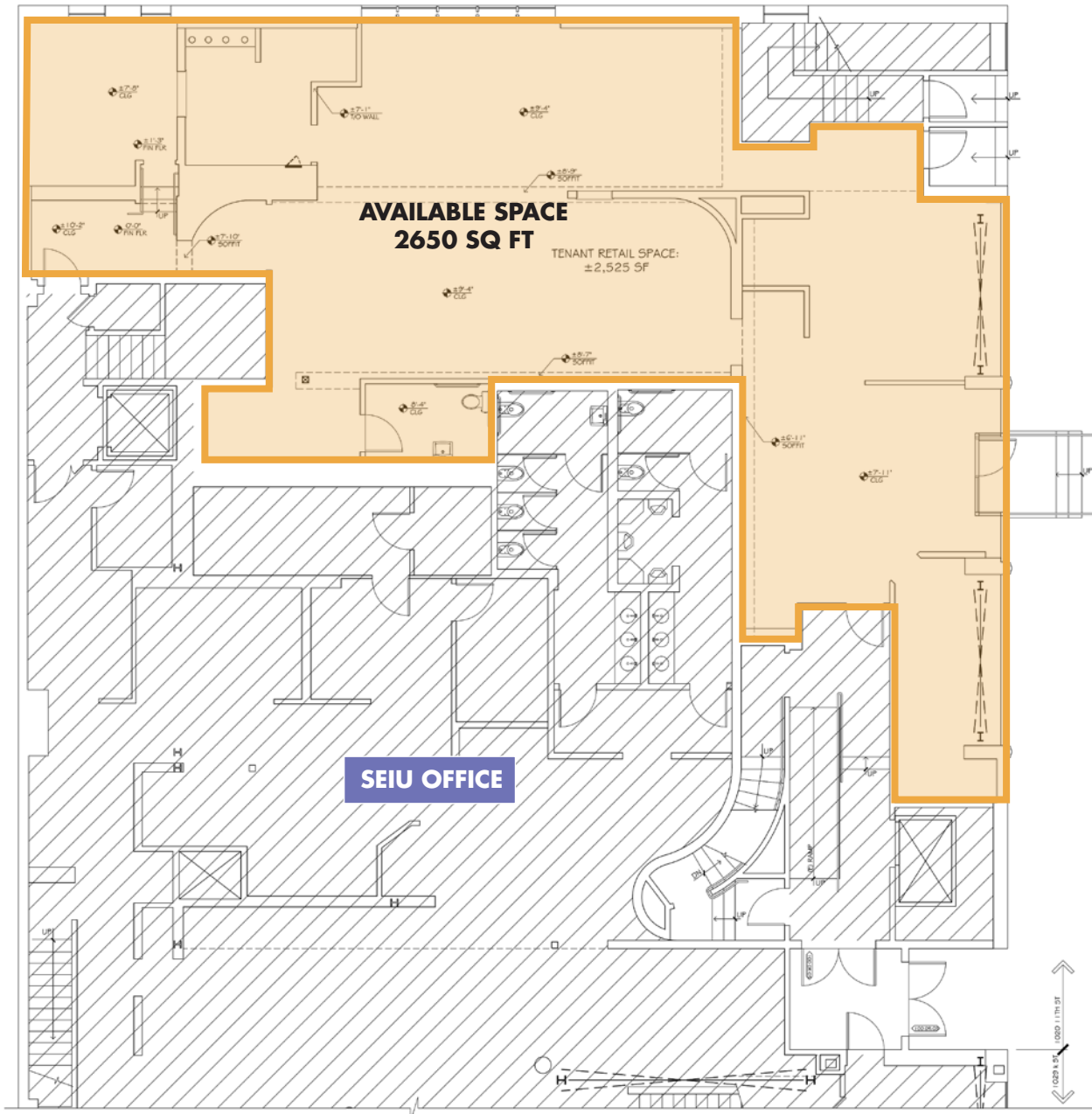

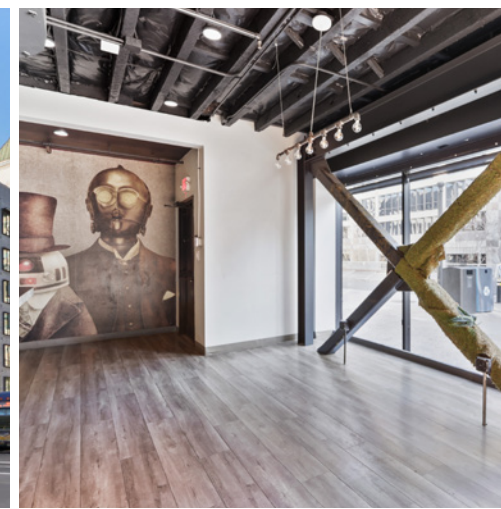

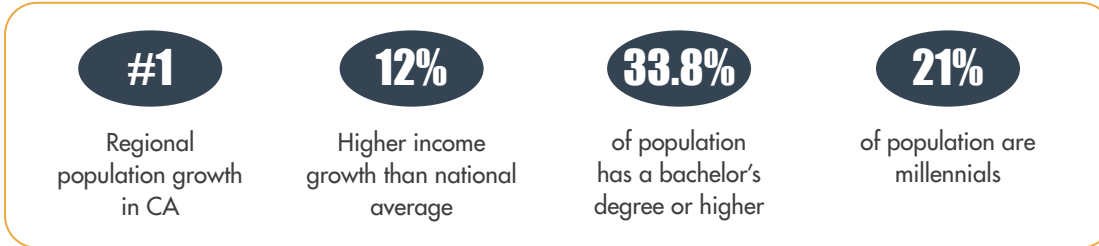

Greater Sacramento's 2.6 million residents are diverse and highly educated

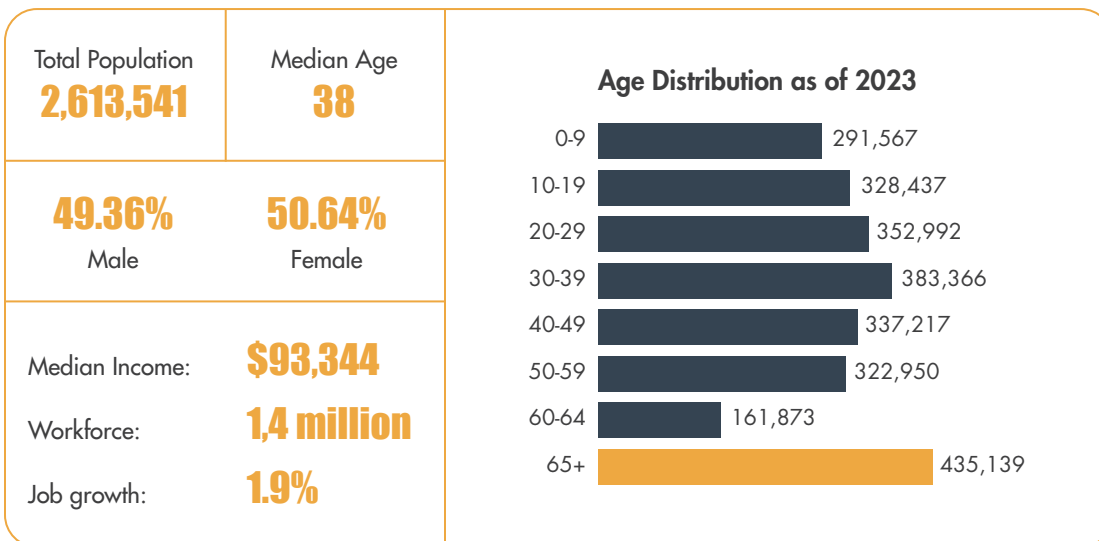

## HISTORIC SIGNIFICANCE

Built in 1911, the M.A.Y. Building was created to showcase the Mohr and Yoerk Market—the first West Coast market to combine meat products with a variety of foods from other departments, laying the foundation for modern supermarkets!



In 1933, the ground-floor market was remodeled to house the women's clothing store Bon Marché. When Bon Marché closed, Ransohoff's department store purchased the building in 1956. Since Ransohoff's closure in 1990, the building has hosted a supper club, a brewery, and an art gallery. In 2003, the apartments were renovated to accommodate office space.

The M.A.Y. Building has been meticulously restored to honor its historic roots while incorporating modern conveniences. Highlights include:

- 21 elegantly renovated luxury apartments.
- The Capitol Event Center: a 200-person venue ideal for conferences and celebrations.
- Ground-floor retail spaces blending historic charm with contemporary functionality, offering distinctive appeal to tenants and visitors alike.
